



APCO 2016, APCO International's Annual Conference & Expo, is the premier event for public safety communications officials, from frontline telecommunicators to comm center managers to public safety communications equipment and services vendors. Starting August 14, APCO 2016 offers four days of educational sessions, committee meetings and special events, paired with two full days of exhibits.

- The first APCO International Conference was held January 21, 1935 in St. Louis, MO and APCO has held one annually each year since then.

- Last year approximately 2,500 public safety communications officials and 280 exhibiting companies attended the Conference in Washington, DC.
- APCO 2015 attendees came from as far away as Senegal, Sri Lanka, Turkey and Australia and represented a total of 30 countries.
- Over four days, more than 100 professional development tracks, three general sessions featuring keynote speakers and several networking events are held.
- Attendees can earn continuing education credits by attending conference sessions.
